NSS Day 2022 - 24th September, 2022.



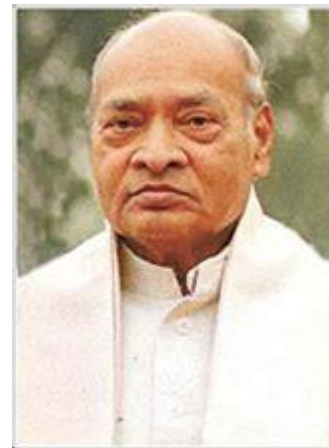
NSS Day, marking 53 years of the founding of the NSS in 1969 was celebrated at GSSS SSFGC, Metagalli Mysore. The programme took place from 10am to 11am on the 24th of September 2022. The chief guest of the programme was the Principal of the Government PU college in Ballenahalli, Lion C R Dinesh. Mr. Dinesh, a long-time member of the NSS, spoke of his experiences in the organization, and the expectations it asked of its members. He spoke



of a famous photographer, by the name of Kevin Carter, who took the famous photograph of the vulture and child, in a war torn, poverty stricken Sudan in 1993, and shocked by his own inhumanity eventually took his own life. He said that if the spirit of service had prevailed over Kevin Carter instead of fame and name (which he achieved through the photograph - he won the Pulitzer Prize for it), he might not have found the situation so hopeless, and may not have taken his own life. He spoke about how connections in the NSS had helped so many of his students in their professional and personal lives and enabled them to acquire many new opportunities as well. He encouraged students to build the nation through the spirit of service through the NSS, much like MC Modi, an ophthalmologist, who restored eyesight to 500,000 people. He encouraged the students to spend time in the field to commit to dedicated service and build a community, and eventually the nation, and saying so, concluded his advice to the students. The principal added that his experience in the NSS had greatly helped in building his personality and instilling a spirit of service into him, and encouraged the students to give to the society, selflessly.
