# **Clubs Orientation Programme**



Around 40 students took part in the activity, making it an engaging and educational start to the club's initiatives for the academic year.



### **World Tigers Day**

The Adventure and Eco Club, The Department of Commerce and Business Administration observed World Tiger Day on 29th July. To mark World Tiger Day and to enrich students with knowledge about tigers and their importance in nature, an awareness session was conducted highlighting the vital role of tigers in maintaining forest ecosystems. Students were presented with information on how tigers, as apex predators, help balance the food chain and protect forest health, while also learning that forest conservation is essential for the survival of tigers. A video was also screened to showcase how tigers live in their natural habitats, offering students a closer look at their behavior and the challenges they face. The program successfully deepened students' understanding of the interdependence between tigers and forests, and emphasized the importance of wildlife conservation.
