### Orientation Program for E-Attestation Officers and Principals

On 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019, college development council organized the orientation program regarding State Post-Metric Scholarship for the principals and e-attestation officers of affiliated colleges of University of Mysore. I attended the program to update myself about the latest developments in the portal.

CDC director Sri Srikantaswamy, Registrar Sri Shivappa, Prof Mahadev, Nodal Officer Smt Veena Mathad inaugurated the program. Sri Manju, Consultant for e-governance and Computer Maintenance Corporation was the convenor of the program.

The CDC Director in his speech highlighted the need for creating a database of the teachers and students which will help in regular progress monitoring and also sensitizing the training program. The students' Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER) in higher education has been declining drastically and steps have to be taken to improve it.

One of the main reasons for the fall in GER is the financial constraints faced by the students and also lack of awareness about the facilities provided to the Students by the government. Student Scholarship Portal is the answer to all these problems. The new portal has been opened for providing scholarships for students from pre-university to PhD. This is an adhaar enabled payment system along with which bank accounts have to be seeded.

The portal has been linked to various departments of social Welfare, Tribal welfare, minorities, backward classes, Technical education, Medical education and Ayush.

Principal's roles and responsibilities

- 1) Create awareness among students about the portal through Whatsapp groups and other social media.
- 2) Providing College Information like courses combinations, fees charged and e-attestation officers etc.

There was a video on procedure for applying to the scholarship s by post-metric students, followed by an interaction session with the audience.

## *Winners of Infosys Prize 2019*



The Prestigious Infosys Prize also called Nobel Prize of India, 2019 was announced in a glittery ceremony in Bangalore on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019. The Program started at 11 AM on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019 in Convention hall, Infosys corporate office, Electronics City, Bangalore.

I was privileged to be a part of prestigious Infosys Prize 2019 hosted by Infosys science foundation. I represented our college director, Dr Prabhakara K V who is one of the panelists of the prize committee.



**Dr Prabhakara K V**

The Infosys Prize is an annual award given to scientists, researchers, engineers and social scientists of Indian Origin (not necessarily born in India) by the Infosys Science Foundation and ranks among the highest monetary awards in India to recognize research. The prize for each category includes a gold medallion, a citation certificate, and prize money of US\$100,000 (or its equivalent in Indian Rupees).

The prize purse is tax free in the hands of winners in India. In 2008, the prize was jointly awarded by the Infosys Science Foundation and National Institute of Advanced Studies for mathematics. The following year, three additional categories were added: Life Sciences, Mathematical Sciences, Physical Sciences and Social Sciences. In 2010, Engineering and Computer Science was added as a category. In 2012, a sixth category, Humanities, was added.
