About the Workshop

The competence of teachers plays a pivotal role in mentoring, development and counseling students and their empowerment. The objective is to strengthen teachers learning process by complete involvement in training programs to achieve academic excellence and using it for value transmission to facilitate teachers to perform different roles effectively in the society. About 125 institutions are expected to take part in the program.

Objectives

2. To bring to the notice of the participants the need for identifying competencies for developing, counselling and mentoring.
3. To guide participants chalk out plans for continuous interventions for students through developing, counselling and mentoring.
4. To assist teachers in identifying strategies and methods through intervention of developing, counselling and mentoring.
5. To help the institution to institutionalize systems of developing, counselling and mentoring in their institution.
6. To create interest among the teachers to volunteer to become resource developers, counsellors and mentors.
