GSSSIETW observed Partition Horrors Remembrance Day with a short programme on the 12<sup>th</sup> of August 2022. The HoD of Commerce, Mrs. Madhu R U accompanied some students of GSSS SSFGC. Some students of the BCA, BBA and BCom courses sang patriotic songs at the ceremony of honour and remembrance for the victims of the violence that followed the partition of India in 1947. A student of GSSS SSFGC gave a speech on the hardships and horrors suffered by the victims of the partition and promoted peace and understanding, asking people to come to peaceful decisions, instead of violent



bloodshed. The ceremony was a solemn commemoration of the past, reminding people of the grave mistakes that had been made, and a warning to us that we should never go down the same path.

### Partition Horrors Remembrance Day at GSSS SSFGC

GSSS SSFGC observed a day of remembrance for the Indian men and women who lost their lives during the partition of India in 1947 on the 13<sup>th</sup> of August 2022. A slideshow made by the Govt. of



India was presented for the students. The slideshow showcased the horrors suffered by the people during the Partition which included deaths, assaults, robbery, etc. This was followed by a short speech by the principal – Dr Rakesh T S who asked the students to never take the

country and the life that they were given for granted, and work hard to make their country proud. The programme concluded with 2 minutes of silence observed in honour and memory of the victims of the Partition.
