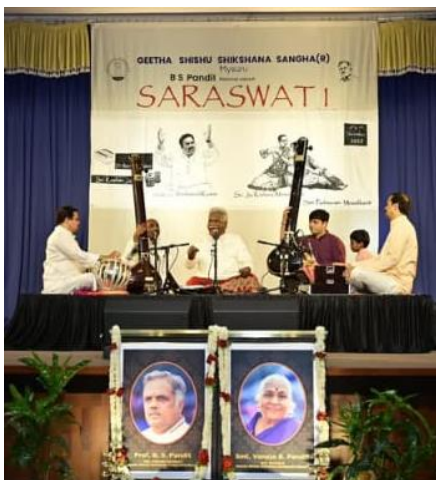


B.S. Pandit Memorial Concert 'Saraswati'
