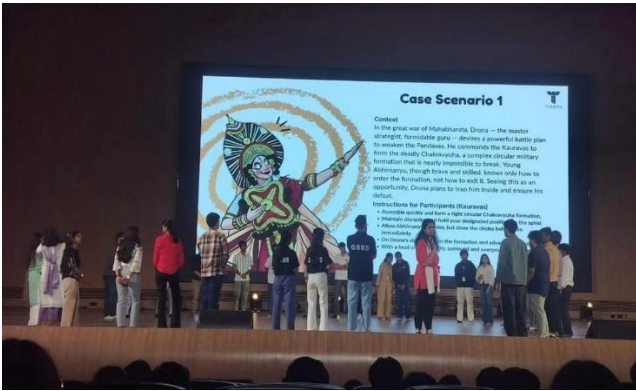
Clean Trail Crew-2026

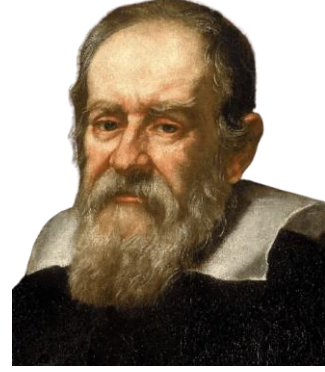
