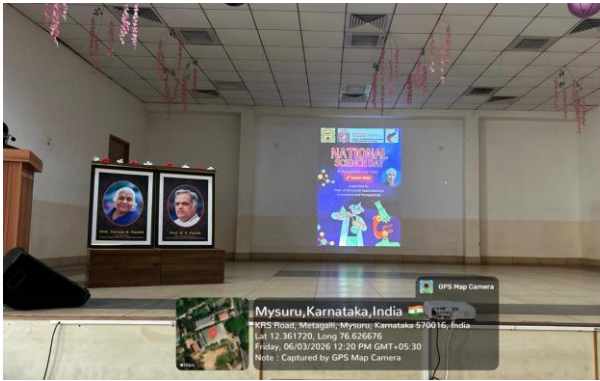

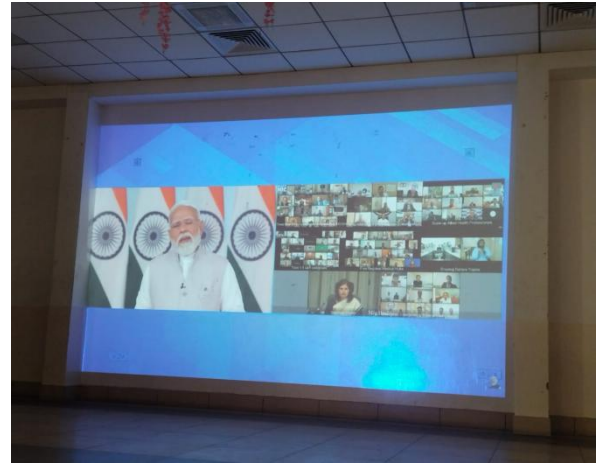


Sabka Saath Sabka Vikas- Webinar

Gita Samhitha-2026

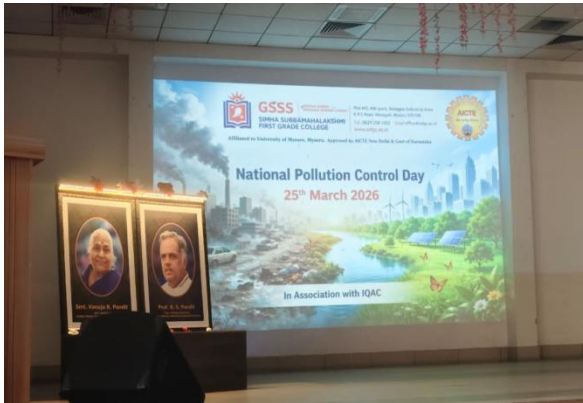
