Technical Talk on Generative AI

A technical talk on “*Generative AI – Concepts, Tools, and Applications*” was organized by the Department of BCA, GSSS SSGC, Mysuru, on 11th October 2025, delivered by Mr. Girish Hosamani, Technical Lead at Mastek Ltd., Bengaluru. The session introduced students to the fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence and highlighted how Generative AI differs from traditional AI by enabling machines to create new content such as text, images, and code. Mr. Hosamani discussed the importance of Large Language Models (LLMs) like GPT and BERT, and Vector Databases for managing data embeddings efficiently. He also explained the working principles of Generative AI models, their diverse applications in software development, design, and data analytics, and demonstrated popular AI tools and frameworks such as OpenAI, Hugging Face, and LangChain. The concept of hybrid models combining traditional and generative AI approaches was also explored. The session was highly informative and provided valuable insights into the growing impact of Generative AI in modern industries.



Technical Quiz

The Department of Computer Applications organized an IT Club activity titled “Technical Quiz on Python, Riddles, and Operating System” on **October 15, 2025**, for final-year **BCA students**. The event aimed to enhance students’ technical knowledge, problem-solving skills, and logical reasoning through an engaging and competitive quiz format.
