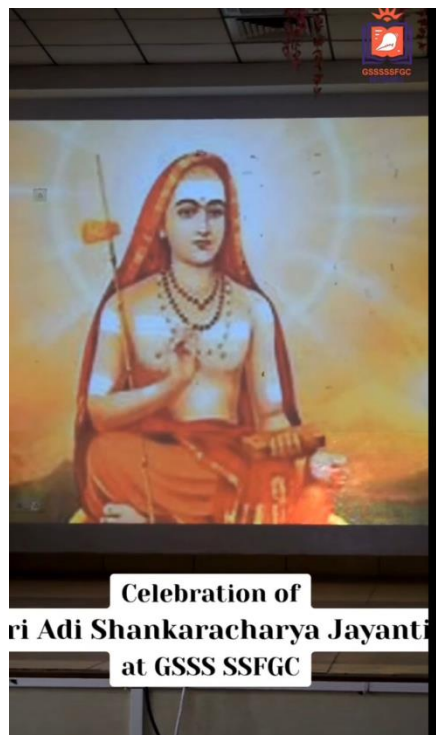


Ethnic Day

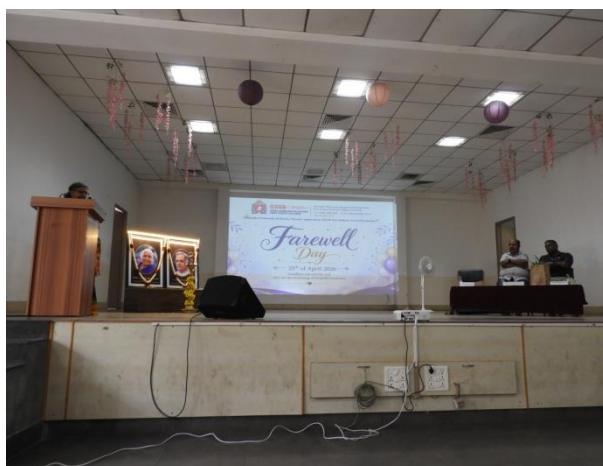
Shankara Jayanthi
