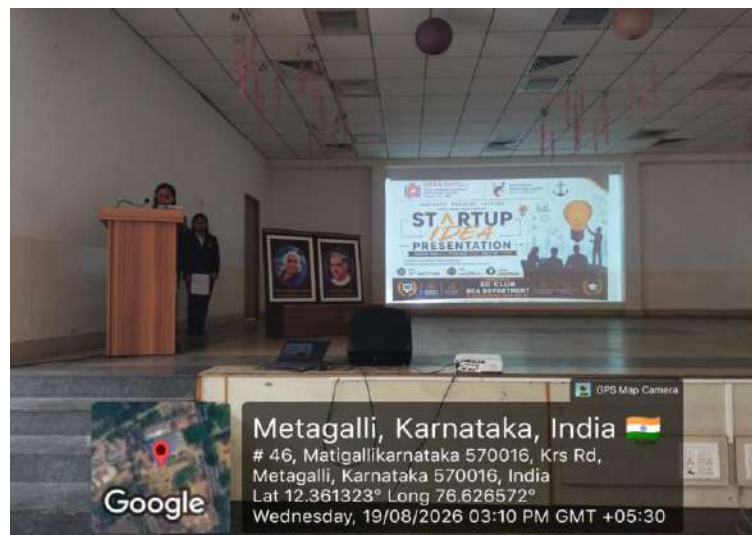
Independence Day Celebration
